We have all the materials for the restoration and we have applied for the permit with BCS. AMRC tested the building for lead and it was determined all the paint that is still remaining has lead in it. A plan to remove the lead is already set forth and we will be starting the project as soon as the permit is ready. The restoration will take a couple of months. Pictures of the restoration will happen daily. If Lemon Bay would still like to donate the funds we could use it for the compacted shell that will go around the building and out to the road or they can help with the restoration of the interior artifacts and or the electrical.
